ENTERING ONLINE FOR THE 2023 NATIONAL STANDARDBRED HORSE SHOW

1. Pre entries due online by Saturday, September 16, 2023
2. Go to equestriantentries.com/userhome
3. Log in or “join now” to create a new account
 - a. If you create a new account, make sure to:
 - i. Click the link in your email to verify your account
 - ii. Finish setting up your contact info
4. If not automatically redirected, go back to equestriantentries.com/userhome
5. Before entering, you must add Ride, Owner, Trainer, Horse
6. Click “Enter a Show” or go to equestriantentries.com/showcalendar
7. Scroll down to the **2023 National Standardbred Horse Show** and click the orange “Sign Up” button
8. From the dropdowns, select the rider, horse, and trainer. You will need to submit a separate entry for each horse/rider combination. Click next.
9. Select the classes you would like to enter each day (please reference the [PRIZE LIST](#))
 - a. You must also select a division for each class. This is a requirement of the entry software. Please select the same division for every class for each horse/rider combo.
10. Select stabling options – the earliest you can select will be Friday, 9/22, but you may move onto the grounds on Thursday, 9/21.
11. When you get to the Signature Pages / Coggins / Entry Docs page, you must upload a photo of your horse’s current Coggins
 - a. Once you upload the photo, click “Back to my Entry”
 - b. Click the red “click to include” button next to the correct Coggins
12. You do not need to do anything on the USEF member check screen, proceed to next step.
13. Review your entry and select “proceed to checkout”
14. Review the fees for your entry and select “proceed to checkout”
15. When you get to the payment screen, proceed with payment via credit card
 - a. If you would prefer to bring an open check with you to the horse show, email Debra McCluskey at debralmclluskey@yahoo.com to let her know.
 - b. Your entry will say “not paid/submitted” but Debra will receive it
 - c. You must supply an open check to the show office when checking in.

1. ALL HORSES MUST BE PRE-ENTERED BY SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2023
2. Pre-entries must be accompanied by a credit card payment, or an open check received in the show office before a horse competes.
3. ALL STALLS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. Horse stalls are available at \$100 for the weekend. Tack stalls are available at \$75 for the weekend.
4. Horses will be judged according to the SPHO-NJ rulebook
www.sphonj.org/rules
5. ALL horses entered must be full Standardbreds, registered with the USTA. Must show proof of registration by lip tattoo, freeze brand and/or registration papers before entering the first class. Tattoos WILL be checked by a DQP.
6. Stalls do not include bedding and no bedding will be available for purchase at the show. Please only use shavings. No straw or other bedding is permitted.
7. No stabling at the Horse Park before Wednesday at 6:00pm. Stalls must be vacated by noon on Monday, September 25.
8. Schooling in designated areas only.
9. Camper hookups are available near the stable area at a fee of \$150 for the weekend.
10. Proof of negative Coggins test dated within 12 months for out-of-state horses and 24 months for in-state horses must be provided. Horses coming from out of state must have a health certificate dated within 30 days of the show.
11. No refunds will be granted without a vet's certificate (stall, EMT and office fees will not be refunded).
12. Approved helmets required for exhibitors 18 years and under when riding or driving. Speed and fun classes recommend helmets for ALL exhibitors. Failure to follow this rule will result in being excused from the ring.
13. Dogs must be leashed. The HPNJ \$50.00 fine will be imposed for loose dogs.
14. Only standard cavessons are permitted in all pleasure, hunter, and equitation classes.
15. No martingales or tie-downs permitted in under saddle and equitation flat classes. Games excluded.

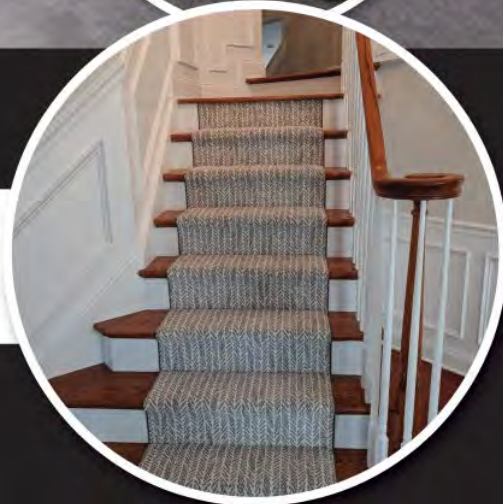

NATIONAL STANDARDBRED HORSE SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS (CONT'D):

16. Disrespect to a judge or show official will not be tolerated, and will disqualify the exhibitor, resulting in forfeiture of all entry fees.
17. No one may approach the judge during the competition unless accompanied by the Show Manager.
18. All horses must be serviceably sound. Racing blemishes not to count. Show judge's decision will be final. If excused, remaining entry fees will be refunded.
19. Exhibitors are notified that the Horse Park of NJ only allows drugs and medications to be administered by a show vet.
20. Holds on classes must be requested in the office before the start of the session where the conflict occurs. Only exhibitors with back-to-back classes will be granted holds.
21. Exhibitors are responsible for having their entries at ringside when their class is called. A "two-minute rule" will be in effect on the gate.
22. Rules not explicitly covered in the SPHO-NJ rulebook will defer to the guidelines of the associated governing body for the discipline.
23. Any class descriptions that are not answered on this prize list will defer to the guidelines of the associated governing body for the discipline.
24. In the case of a tie for Champion, the classes used to break the tie will be marked in the Division descriptions with an exclamation point (!).
25. Exhibitors must declare their horses as either Rookie, Green, Novice, or Senior on the entry form. Improperly classifying your horse will result in disqualification with no refund of entry fees and will also change the horse's eligibility status.
26. All returned checks will be subject to a \$35 surcharge.
27. Neither the Standardbred Pleasure Horse Organization of NJ, Inc. nor the Horse Park of NJ will be responsible for any accident of any kind or nature that may occur to any person, animal or property, and the exhibitor shall hold the Committee or Property Owner harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceeding arising from such accident.
28. The Show Committee and/or the Horse Park of NJ reserve the right to amend, add or clarify any rules that are found to be unsafe, unclear, or potentially misconstrued.
29. All judge's results are official.

- The intermediate gait is any gait the horse performs naturally between the walk and the canter. This may be a trot, jog, pace, running walk or rack. They will be judged at judges' discretion.
- A Junior Exhibitor is an exhibitor 18 years and under as of November 1 of the current show year.
- All exhibitor age restriction classes will be the age as of November 1, 2022
- SPHO-NJ Jersey Bred Horse: A horse that was sired by a stallion standing in New Jersey at time of conception or a horse that was born in NJ.
- SPHO-NJ Rookie Horse: Horses with no previous show experience. In-hand not to count.
- SPHO-NJ Green Horse: Horses which have won 0-6 blue ribbons in riding or driving events. In-Hand & non-show activities excluded.
- SPHO-NJ Novice Horse: Horses which have won 7 to 12 blue ribbons in riding or driving events.
- SPHO-NJ Senior Horse: Horses which have won more than 12 blue ribbons in riding or driving events. SPHO-NJ Open Horse All horses and riders are eligible to enter.

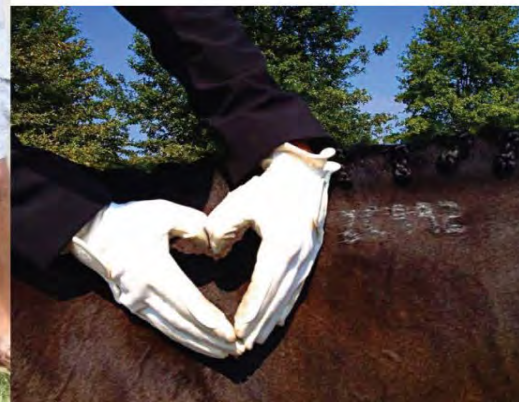
